

- Create a template for Executive Council Minutes and Convention Minutes for consistency throughout
- Send minutes through email after the conclusion of a Executive Council meeting no later than 24 hours after the conclusion
- Disperse the Convention Minutes no later than 7 days past the 2026 Southeast District Convention
- Plan a Social Media calendar and utilize Meta Business Suite for scheduling posts and making posts accessible for the Instagram account so everyone has a timeline to ensure accurate and timely information to the district without bombarding the feed.
- Ensure officers from each chapter in the Band App are up to date with records found in **OPUS**
- Posting of a Monthly Update Newsletter for the District in addition to posts necessary in the Band App

- · Assess the impact of the Rainy Day Fund, and work from there to develop a plan to help collect funds for the Rainy Day Fund
